Some resources are always available including lots of toys and games inside the house and in the garden; paper and craft at the table; role play resources etc.

Children's individual routines are followed through the day including meals and sleep times.

It is up to you how much detail you want to go into about your day-to-day planning. I tend to keep mine short. I also have -

- Risk assessments for the outings and planned activities;
- Our weekly planning overview shared with parents;
- Observations of things children are doing / saying which link to the planning;
- Notes about things the child has done /enjoyed see my play plan;
- Notes about spontaneous things children are doing / saying see my play plan.
